1 Greeting (3 minutes)
2 Lesson 6 Tips for Speaking (p. 75) Shopping
(1) Teachers to demonstrate the script for Shopping (5 mins)

Materials: Powerpoint, 24 Handouts
Demonstrate the whole dialogue first, then let the class practice together (left side as buyer, right side as seller, then switch roles.)
*Seller dialogue does not need to be memorized, Sellers will be given scripts. But buyer dialogue must be memorized.

## Sample Dialogue:

Seller $=$ S, Buyer $=B$
S: Hello! OR Good afternoon!
Welcome to $\qquad$ (shop name).
May I help you?
B: Yes, I'm looking for a nice $\qquad$ (shirt/pair of pants/pair of shoes)
S: How about this one?
B: Hmmm… it's too large/small for me.
Do you have any smaller/larger ones?
S: Sure, I recommend this one.
B: Hmmm $\cdots$ it's too expensive for me.
Do you have any cheaper ones?
S: Sure, I recommend this one.
B: May I try it on?
S: Of course.
B: Thanks.
(2) Shopping Role Play (40 minutes)

Materials: 6 Store Displays. Shopping List Pictures (3 rounds $\times 12$ buyers), Shopping Items (3 rounds $\times 6$ stores $\times 6$ items)

In this shopping role play, buyers will be given a "Shopping List" picture, indicating the item, color, size of the item and the budget price. Buyers must find the shop selling the correct color item, and ask the seller for the correct
size and price.
(1) Teacher to divide the class into 6 groups of 3 members. (Groups will be based on seating arrangement, 3 people sitting together.)
(2) There will be 3 different shopping rounds (1 shopping item for each round of role-play).
(3) Each group will decide which member will be the seller for each shopping round. The other members will be the buyers for that shopping round.
Everyone will get to practice speaking as a buyer $2 x$, and practice as a seller 1x.

Round 1 ( 10 minutes) - shirts
(4) The sellers will come to the front and stand beside a Store Display selling shirts, pants, and shoes. (different color per store.)
(5) The buyers will be given 1 shopping list card that indicates the item they need to buy, the color, the size, and budget price.
(6) The buyers will look for the matching (same color) Store Display and talk to the seller.
(7) The buyer must ask for the correct size, and the seller will offer the correct size, but expensive price.
(8) The buyer must ask for the cheaper price, and the seller will offer the correct price. The buyer will then take the correct item (correct color, size, price.)
(9) The round finishes in 10 minutes. (2 buyers per store).

Round 2, 3, (10 minutes)
(10) The second round will be played with a different set of sellers and a different shopping item - pants, shoes.
