“Break the ice”



意味：〔氷を砕く〕緊張をほぐす
例：His joke helped break the ice.

“On thin ice”



意味：〔薄氷を踏むように〕危険な状態で
例：After not doing his homework again, John was on thin ice with his teacher.

“Chill out”



意味：落ち着く、くつろぐ
例：You should chill out after you finish your homework.

“The cold shoulder”



意味：〔冷たいかた肩〕人を無視する、よそよそしい
例：I tried to apologize, but she gave me the cold shoulder.

“Cold feet”



意味：〔足が冷えた〕おじけづく

例：He got cold feet before the wedding.

“The tip of the iceberg”



意味：氷山の一角に過ぎない

例：Hiragana is just the tip of the iceberg!
