"On thin ice"



意味: [氷を砕く] 緊張をほぐす

例: His joke helped <u>break the ice</u>.

意味: 〔薄氷を踏むように〕 危険な状態で

例: After not doing his homework again,
John was on thin ice with his teacher.

"Chill out"



"The cold shoulder"



意味:落ち着く、くつろぐ

例: You should <u>chill out</u> after you finish your homework.

意味: [冷たいかた肩] 人を無視する、 よそよそしい

例: I tried to apologize, but she gave me the cold shoulder.

"Cold feet"

"The tip of the iceberg"





意味: 〔足が冷えた〕 おじけづく

例:He got <u>cold feet</u> before the wedding.

意味:氷山の一角に過ぎない

例:Hiragana is just the tip of the iceberg!
